IF YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS FOR OTHER DEPARTMENTS, BRING THEM UP AT MEETINGS - EXTRA PAGES CAN BE ADDED TO THIS BOOKLET.

## REPORTER (S)

A REPORTER SHOULD :

- (a) WRITE ARTICLES ON EVENTS NOT COVERED BY OTHER DEPARTMENTS  
(i.e. - EXPOSITION)
- (b) WRITE ARTICLES OF GENERAL INTEREST TO STUDENTS
- (c) WRITE ARTICLES TO BE SUBMITTED TO VARIOUS EDITORS

THE ENTIRE STAFF SHOULD BE CONCERNED WITH REPORTING  
TO A CERTAIN EXTENT.

## LITERARY EDITOR

THE LITERARY EDITOR SHOULD WRITE OCCASIONAL ARTICLES, PREFERABLY ABOUT SCHOOL, BUT IN A LITERARY MANNER — OR SELECT ARTICLES FROM INTERNATIONAL MAGAZINES AND NEWSPAPERS. (OF INTEREST TO STUDENTS)

ALSO: THE RAMBLER WILL PUBLISH A LITERARY SUPPLEMENT IN FEBRUARY CONSISTING ENTIRELY OF STUDENTS' WORKS. THE LITERARY EDITOR WILL BE IN CHARGE OF THIS SPECIAL FEATURE — THE CO-OPERATION OF THE SCHOOL ENGLISH DEPARTMENT TO BE SOUGHT OUT FOR HELP IN OBTAINING AND JUDGING THESE.

THE S.C. REPORTER SHOULD PREPARE AN ACCOUNT OF EACH FULL STUDENTS' COUNCIL MEETING TO BE INCLUDED IN EACH ISSUE OF THE RAMBLER. (IF TWO OR MORE MEETINGS ARE HELD BETWEEN ISSUES, THE REPORTS SHOULD BE COMBINED INTO ONE)

THIS ACCOUNT SHOULD NOT BE DONE IN THE FORM OF MINUTES, BUT A SHORT REPORT CONFINED TO TWO OR THREE PARAGRAPHS.

THE TREASURER'S REPORT SHOULD BE INCLUDED.

## JOKES

JOKES SHOULD BE ORIGINAL AS POSSIBLE - PREFERABLY COMPLETELY ORIGINAL. DO NOT CONSULT WIDELY - READ CANADIAN AND AMERICAN MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPERS, ETC., FOR MATERIAL, AS THESE JOKES MAY SEEM STALE. (THERE MAY BE A FEW EXCEPTIONS) ALSO - DO NOT CONSULT OTHER SCHOOL MAGAZINES - THE JOKES IN THEM ARE USUALLY THOSE WHICH HAVE BEEN TOSSED ABOUT FROM ONE SCHOOL MAGAZINE TO ANOTHER.

RELIABLE ~~SOURCES~~ SOURCES INCLUDE OTHER MAGAZINES WHICH CONTAIN JOKES WHICH WOULD BE OF CONSIDERABLE INTEREST TO STUDENTS.

EACH ARTICLE SHOULD ~~CONTAIN~~ HAVE, AT THE TOP, THE NAME OF THE CONTRIBUTOR.

BOYS' SPORTS REPORTER - GIRLS' SPORTS REPORTER  
(AND EDITORS)

THE SPORTS REPORTER SHOULD SERVE A POSITION SIMILAR TO THE SOCIAL EDITOR — TO KEEP STUDENTS OF MRSSS AND OTHER SCHOOLS WELL INFORMED ON SPORTS EVENTS AT THE SCHOOL.

THESE EVENTS INCLUDE:

SOCCER  
VOLLEYBALL  
BASKETBALL

THE REPORTERS SHOULD PROVIDE COMPLETE SCORE INFORMATION AS WELL AS OCCASIONAL COMMENTS FROM PLAYERS, COACHES, MANAGERS, ETC., AND INTERVIEWS WITH SPORTS PERSONALITIES.

REMEMBER THAT WHAT GOES ON BEFORE AND AFTER THE GAME IS OFTEN JUST AS IMPORTANT AS THE GAME ITSELF.

CHECK TO SEE THAT PLAYERS' NAMES ARE SPELT CORRECTLY.

KEEP INFORMED AS TO THE PLANS OF THE ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE. RANDY ARBER (GIRLS SPORTS REP.) & BOB KING (BOYS SPORTS REP.) ARE CO-CHAIRMEN. ALSO, THE FOLLOWING DIVISION REPS ARE MEMBERS OF THE A.A.C.:

## PERSONAL OPINION

EACH WEEK SHOULD CONSIST OF A CROSS SECTION OF REMARKS FROM STUDENTS IN REPLY TO A QUESTION WHICH MAY BE JUST ORDINARY OR CONTROVERSIAL.

THE NUMBER OF OPINIONS MAKES NO DIFFERENCE — IF POSSIBLE, AS MANY AS POSSIBLE. IN AN APRIL ISSUE OF THE P.M.S.S.S. PAPER "THE GREEN AND GOLD" THERE WERE FIFTY OPINIONS AS TO PREFERENCE OF THE BEATLES OR THE DAVE CLARK 5.

DO NOT SUBSTITUTE THE TERM "CENSORED" FOR ANY REMARKS UNLESS THEY ARE OF A CENSORABLE NATURE.

EACH ARTICLE SHOULD SHOW THE NAME OF THE INTERVIEWER AND THE TERM "PERSONAL OPINION" AT THE TOP.

## SOCIAL EDITOR

IN MOST LARGE VANCOUVER SCHOOL NEWSPAPERS, THE SOCIAL EDITOR HOLDS A PROMINENT POSITION.

THE SOCIAL EDITOR SHOULD KEEP RAMBLER READERS WELL INFORMED ON ALL SOCIAL ACTIVITIES. (E.G. - SOCIALS, DANCES, ICE & ROLLER SKATING & SWIM PARTIES, ETC.) HE (SHE) SHOULD PREPARE A "CALENDAR" FOR EACH ISSUE WHICH INCLUDES AS MANY COMING SOCIAL EVENTS AS POSSIBLE, EACH ACCOMPANIED BY THE DATE.

(E.G. -

SEPT. 25 \_\_\_\_\_ GRADUATION  
OCT. 2 \_\_\_\_\_ GRADE 10 INITIATION & DANCE )

REMEMBER THAT EVENTS CONNECTED WITH SCHOOL SHOULD ALSO BE INCLUDED. AN EXAMPLE FROM LAST YEAR WAS THE M.R.A.C. ATHLETIC DISPLAY

SOCIAL EVENTS SHOULD ALSO BE REPORTED ON FOR THE RECORD AS WELL AS FOR THE INTEREST OF THE STUDENTS WHO DID NOT ATTEND THESE FUNCTIONS - SO THEY WILL SEE WHAT THEY ARE MISSING. IF THE SOCIAL EDITOR CANNOT ATTEND HE (SHE) SHOULD DELEGATE SOMEONE TO GET THE DESIRED INFORMATION. THESE REPORTS SHOULD BE BRIEF, BUT INTERESTING.

OTHER SCHOOLS, TO WHICH THE RAMBLER IS SENT, ARE INTERESTED IN THE SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AT MRSSS. - THE SOCIAL EDITOR SHOULD KEEP IN MIND THAT HE IS ALSO PRESENTING A PICTURE OF OUR ACTIVITIES TO THEM

EACH ARTICLE SHOULD HAVE THE SOCIAL EDITOR'S NAME AND THE TERM "SOCIAL" AT THE TOP

## EXCHANGE EDITOR

THE EXCHANGE EDITOR SHOULD CHOOSE TIMELY ARTICLES FROM NEWSPAPERS OF OTHER SCHOOLS.

THE RAMBLER RECEIVES COPIES OF THESE NEWSPAPERS (CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE EDITOR AND SHOULD BE RETURNED TO HIM) — AND WILL RECEIVE MORE FROM OTHER SCHOOLS AFTER WE SEND COPIES OF THE RAMBLER TO THE SCHOOLS TO WHICH WE DID NOT SEND ANY LAST YEAR.

SOME EDITING OF CERTAIN PHRASES IN THESE ARTICLES MAY BE NECESSARY TO SUIT THEM TO MRSSS (e.g. — THE SCHOOL NAMES)

EACH EXCHANGE ARTICLE SHOULD HAVE AT THE TOP OF THE ARTICLE "EXCHANGE" AS WELL AS THE EDITOR'S NAME. ALSO INCLUDE THE NAME OF THE ARTICLE (WHICH HELPS) AS WELL AS THE NAME OF THE NEWSPAPER IT WAS TAKEN FROM AND THE NAME OF THE AUTHOR.
